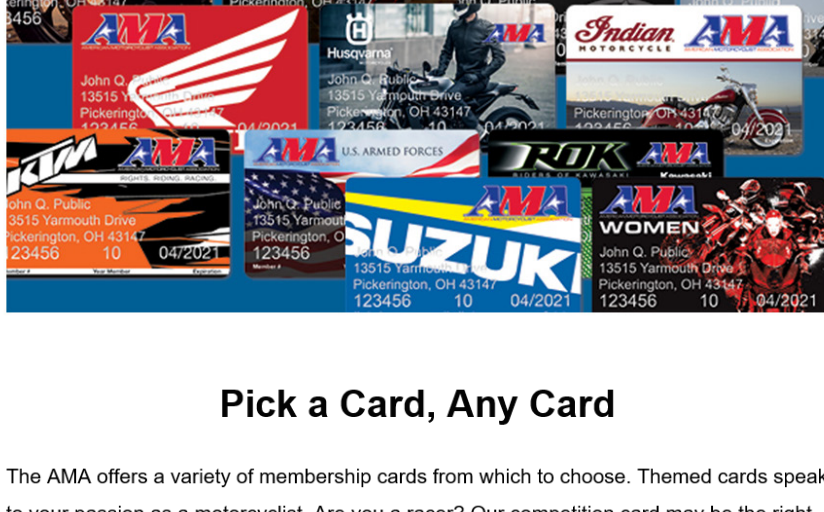




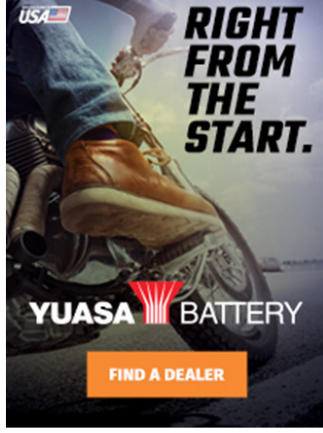

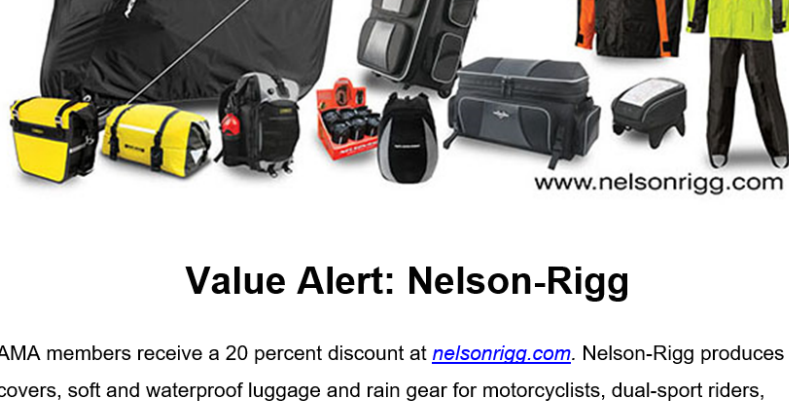


On the Line with the AMA

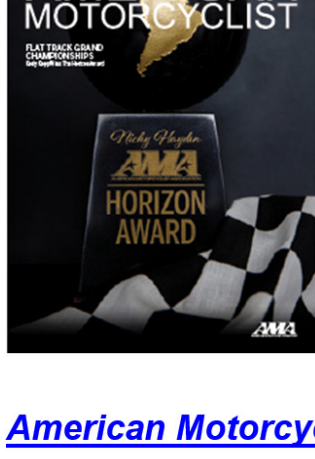

What's on your bucket list of motorcycle rides? [Enter your response.](#)

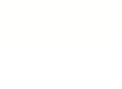
Last month, we asked, "What's your favorite motorcycle movie?" Here is the list of movies we received and the number of members who picked them. We have listed all of them, just in case you haven't seen all of them or want to watch one, or more, of them again.

1. **On Any Sunday** — Seventy-one respondents said this 1971 documentary, which features Steve McQueen and AMA Hall of Famer Malcolm Smith, was their favorite.
2. **World's Fastest Indian** — This 2005 film, starring Anthony Hopkins, Jessica Cauffiel, Joe Howard and Chris Williams, received 31 votes.
3. **Easy Rider** — This 1969 production, which featured Peter Fonda, Dennis Hopper and Terry Southern, came in third with 12 votes.
4. **Wild Hogs** — Starring Tim Allen, John Travolta, Martin Lawrence and William H. Macy, this 2007 comedy garnered six votes.
5. **Long Way Around** — This 2004 documentary series, which followed the on-bike exploits of Ewan McGregor and Charley Boorman, received five votes.
6. **Electra Glide in Blue** — A 1973 film with Robert Blake, Billy "Green" Bush, Mitchell Ryan and Jeannine Riley received four votes.
7. **The Great Escape** — Steve McQueen, James Garner and Richard Attenborough starred in this 1963 film that earned three votes.
8. **Why We Ride** — This 2013 documentary, featuring Jim Adams and Ernie Alexander, and **Dust to Glory**, a 2005 documentary with Mario Andretti, Chad McQueen and Bruce Brown, also received three votes.
9. **Ghost Rider** (2007), **On Any Sunday II** (1981) and **Time Rider** (2005) all received two votes each.

Films that received one vote each include **21 Days Under the Sky** (2016), **Fast Charlie and the Moonbeam Rider** (1979), **Harley and the Davidson** (2016 miniseries), **The Legacy of the African American Motorcyclist** (2005), **Little Fauss and Big Halsy** (1970), **Motonomad III**, **One Week** (2008), **ROAD: Joey Dunlop documentary** (2014), **Roadside Profits** (1992), **Roustabout** (1964), **She Lives to Ride** (1994), **Supercross** (2005) and **Take It to the Limit** (1979).
